The Peace Museum is the only museum in the UK dedicated to the history and untold stories of peace, peacemakers and the peace movement. Our work includes creating new exhibitions, educational outreach, and promoting community cohesion.

With restrictions lifting, we've been able to start running in-person events and education sessions again. It's been a busy few months for The Peace Museum Team, and we have some exciting updates to share with you.

MA Awards 2021



Our project, Peace OUT, has been shortlisted for The Best Small Museum Project Award at this year's Museums Association Museums Change Lives Awards!

The Museums Change Lives Awards celebrate the achievements of museums that are making a difference to the lives of audiences and communities across the UK. The results of this year's awards will be announced on Monday 8th November as part of the MA's annual conference.

Peace OUT was originally an exhibition at the museum in 2019, and has been adapted into a digital exhibition, touring exhibition, and events programme for 2021. The project explores peacemaking within the LGBTQ+ community and features the work of LGBTQ+ artists and campaigners.

The touring Peace OUT exhibition has been on display at Bradford's Bread and Roses Cooperative Café throughout October, and is now moving across the city to The Equity Partnership.

The initial Peace OUT exhibition in our galleries was supported with funding from Museum Development Yorkshire. Peace OUT+ for 2021 was made possible thanks to funding from the Art Fund.

Launched 19th June 2021

We've turned our 2019 Peace OUT exhibition into a digital exhibition. The exhibition aims to explore the journey from Stonewall, an event which marked the beginning of the struggle for LGBTQ+ equality and justice, to the present day. It shares the stories of those who have peacefully campaigned for LGBTQ+ rights and equality and explores the impact LGBTQ+ people have had on peacemaking.

The museum team worked with members of LGBTQ+ communities to co-create this exhibition. The project is part of a wider commitment to contemporary collecting to ensure our collection tells the stories of peacemakers today.

The project has been possible thanks to funding from the Art Fund.

Education Programme

Our education programme is back in full swing, and we're so excited to be working with young people again.

We have just recruited two museum education freelancers with lived experience who are designing new education sessions on LGBTQ+ stories and race equality movements. These sessions will be piloted in January 2022.

We have also hired a new Learning Assistant to help deliver our education sessions in schools!

The museum has been involved in a number of events celebrating the 40th anniversary of the Greenham Common Women's Peace Camp. This included co-hosting a women's disco with Bradford CND and Bradford Women in Black, and two protest badges workshops with artist Layla Khoo at Artworks in Halifax.
